



Kayak the Duwamish River!

Join guides from DRCC, Alki Kayak Tours, Seattle Aquarium Society, and National Wildlife Federation, to learn about the natural and built environments of the Duwamish River.

Kayaking experience is not necessary, and all gear is included. Explore the river to learn about Superfund site cleanup plans, river history, and community activism. You'll also see amazing habitat restoration sites and watchable wildlife, including summer nesting ospreys, seals and sea lions, and shore birds. Tours will also provide basic information about how to make a water quality violation report, and how to take simple water quality tests.
